



Club Captain Position

Role:

Club Captains provide a vital link between the swimmers and coaches/volunteers at LHSS.

The Club Captains will contribute towards the development of the club by assisting on poolside at competition and other events.

Club Captains represent the views of all LHSS swimmers by providing feedback to the Head Coach.

There are two Club Captain roles to be appointed

- Boys Club Captain
- Girls Club Captain

Duties:

Club Captains are expected to:

- Be a positive role model for all members of the club
- Demonstrate pride in LHSS and have a good knowledge of the club
- Be friendly, caring and approachable
- Support their fellow team members by offering guidance and advice
- Be an excellent communicator and provide a voice for other swimmers to raise any issues or suggestions with the Head Coach
- Undertake poolside duties in an enthusiastic manner
- Uphold and demonstrate the principles of fairness, respect, and safety
- Contribute to the Development of LHSS

Conditions:

- Appointments to the Club Captain positions will be announced by the Head Coach in July each year
- Club Captains will be selected from Gold Squad
- Club Captain duties will become effective at the start of the new swimming season in September
- If a Club Captain leaves the club a replacement will be appointed for the remainder of the season
- Each Club Captain will be provided with a Club Captain t-shirt to be worn at every competition
